MINI-POLYTUNNELS are the perfect solution for small plots where space is at a premium. They'll work a treat in back yards, city gardens, patios and can even be used on raised beds.

The tunnels are ideal for growyour-own. And when crops are harvested in autumn, the minipolytunnel can be swung into action again to protect tender

plants during the colder months.

Mini-polytunnels are available from First Tunnels in three lengths with a choice of polythene or net covers. Each hoop is made from strong galvanised steel tubing (reaching a height of 3ft, 7in, while tunnels have 1ft, 9in straight sides). They even come with two extensions to allow ventilation.

The polythene cover is the
