irrigation system is Gardena's Hose-End Irrigation Controller. This easy-to-install unit is simple to use and weather resistant, requiring one 9v battery. Set watering durations from one minute to three hours with up to three start times per day.

The Big Drippa kit is ideal for polytunnels that are not

near mains water (such as on an allotment). It has a 10.5litre reservoir bag and hanging hook, plus five metres of hose and six adjustable drippers.
